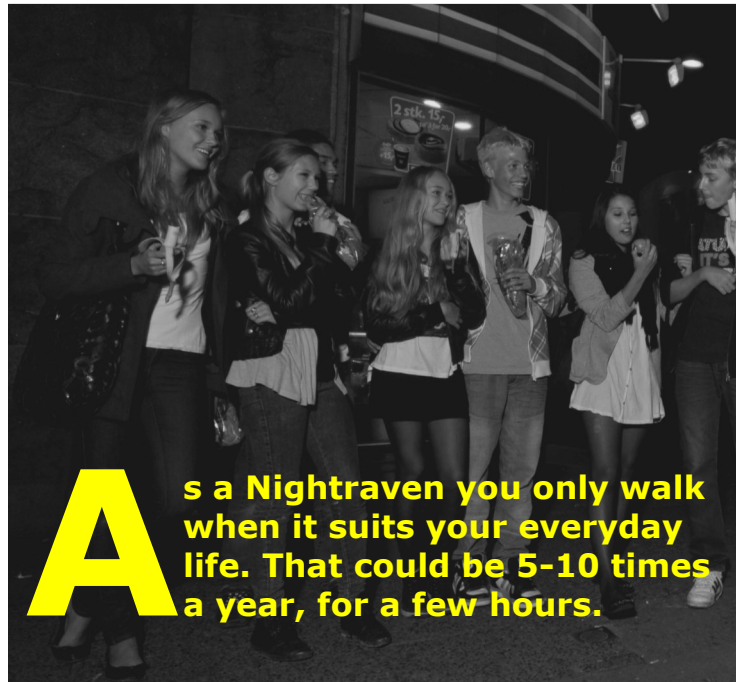

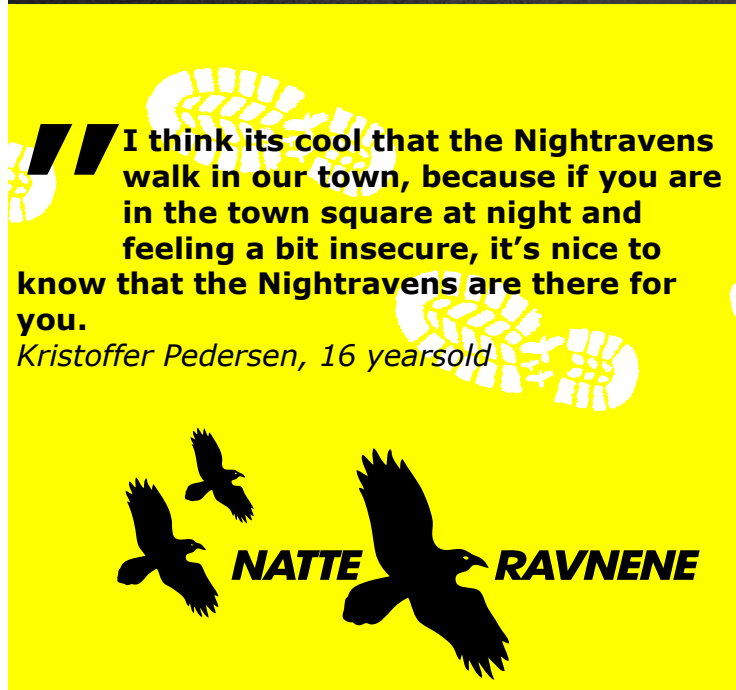

A small concept with big effect

Denmark had its first Nightravens in 1998. And more are joining us every month, because it has become evident that just by their mere presence, the Nightravens increases the feeling of security for both young and old people. Moreover, the Nightravens also contributes to the limitation of vandalism, violence and petty crime in the areas where they walk.

5 golden rules:

- What you need to know to be a Nightraven

- 1** The Nightravens are **visible** and they **observe**, but they never intervene physically in disturbances—in stead they call for professional help if needed.
- 2** The Nightravens always walk **in teams of three** wearing the characteristic yellow clothing.
- 3** The Nightravens always walk in **public** —on the streets, in busses or trains. They never enter clubs, pubs etc.
- 4** The Nightravens are always ready to **listen** and talk to the young people at their initiative. We do not counsel—in cases where needed we refer to professionals or the young peoples' parents or close relatives.
- 5** The Nightravens **help** lost children and young people - preferable through their friends and family. The teams do not walk anybody home and they never loan out money.



What are the Nightravens?

Voluntary and social work

The Nightravens are responsible and adult volunteers, who walk in public to be present for primarily children and young people. They walk in teams of three both men and women in the characteristic yellow clothing—some walk in the afternoon, others in the evening or at night.

The Nightravens are NOT a local vigilante or surveillance. They are caring adults who want to make an effort in creating a safe local environment, positive togetherness and happy young people.

The contact with children and young people

The contact to the young people is always at their initiative, and the Nightravens often give out candy, so that there is an occasion for a small-talk. That is a way for the Nightravens to get to know the young people and contribute to a sensible behavior in public.
